Treasurer's Report-Beth VanSteenkiste

- Cash Balance: \$18,169.27
- Silent Auction Basket money is available for teachers this school year
- We have generated a profit this year of \$1,300 after all expenses from this year and last

- In order to file the electronic postcard those numbers need to stay below \$50,000, PEP is able to run Dave Sutter's donation through PEP and stay within these guidelines

Old Business

- Spaghetti Dinner/Silent Auction: PEP lost about \$50 hosting the event. \$1,245 was raised for the classrooms/departments that participated which was approx. half the market value of the baskets.
- Santa Shop: We raised \$2,030 and we received \$500 from Kohl's by having their assistance during the first day of the sale
- Music Concert Concessions: \$137 was raised for the Music Dept fund
